YOU SAID – WE DID Action against set priorities

Operation Handbrake has been running as a priority in our area since the beginning of the year.

We did initially see a massive reduction in thefts from motor vehicles, however over the last three months, the figures have risen again.

The main area that has been hit with this crime is in the north of our area. We have had increased patrols in the area, including unmarked police cars and undercover police officers patrolling.

We have used the Louth Police Cadets to try and educate people into ensuring that they do not leave any valuables and always lock their vehicles.

We have also sent out many LincsAlert messages to inform people that the crimes are happening, we asked for the village newsletters to also inform people.

We will continue our patrols in the northern

area with the view of reducing these crimes and catching the offenders.

<u>Thefts from Motor Vehicles – Holton le Clay,</u> <u>Tetney and North Thoresby Area</u>

We have seen an increase in thefts from motor vehicles in these areas, a high proportion of the vehicles have been left insecure with valuables inside. We cannot stress enough the importance of always ensuring that your vehicle is locked and secure with no valuables inside. If you do need to leave any valuables in the vehicle, please ensure that these are out of sights. Patrols in the area have been increased and we would urge anyone to contact us if they see anyone acting suspiciously.

Burglaries – Ludford and Utterby

On 02/07/2013, we have two day time burglaries reported to us. Incident 381 02/07 was on Church Lane, Utterby where entry had been gained by damaging a UPVC rear door, once inside offenders stole numerous items including a 55" TV and various items of jewellery.

Incident 283 02/07/2013, was a property on Magna Mile, Ludford. Offenders had entered the property whilst the occupant was outside in the garden. Offenders entered through an unlocked door and once inside stole a wallet.
