

Smoked haddock with mussels, bacon and cannellini beans

Serves 4-6

Ingredients

50g unsalted butter
2large finely sliced onions
6 rashers smoked streaky bacon
2 x 400g tins cannellini beans
500g smoked haddock
1 bay leaf
400ml whole milk
250ml fish stock
1kg fresh mussels
Chopped fresh parsley



Method

Heat butter and gently fry onions for 10 mins. Add chopped bacon and fry for 5 mins. Then add beans and heat for 5 mins.

Put haddock in another pan and cover with milk and bay leaf. Bring to boil. Remove from heat and cover. Leave for 5 mins. Remove fish and flake. Removing bones and skin. Add fish and 2 ladlesful of milk to beans.

Boil stock and add prepared mussels and cover. Cook for 3 mins then shake pan. Discard any that haven't opened. Add mussels and stock to beans. Taste, season and add parsley.

A nice crusty bread is great for mopping up the juices!

Peace is a necessary quality to hold in our hearts for us to enjoy the blessings we find in Jesus.



Did you know?

Our Historic Church

One of the exciting features of our village Church, St Peter's is a little mouse.

Although the oldest parts of the Church date back to Saxon times, in a part of the village recorded in the Domesday Book, the church had to be restored in more recent times due to fire damage, and in about 1850, some of the Church was rebuilt with red brick. One more recent addition was the oak communion rail; if you look carefully, you can see a little mouse carved into the rail.




The Mouse was the work of Robert Thompson, a British furniture maker born in 1876, who is also known as 'Mousey' or 'Mouseman'. He is now famous for his work in oak, from church interiors to furniture and smaller items such as cheese boards. Every piece features his company's trade mark of a little carved mouse.

Robert Thompson told the story that this started when one of his workers claimed that 'we are all as poor as church mice'. His family firm still makes furniture to this day, although older pieces can be seen on antique television shows.

Apprentices have to learn how to include the mouse into the products they are carving during their apprenticeship at Robert Thompson's.

You are welcome to visit the church and see if you can find the little $_{\mathbf{4}}$ mouse.
