# Parish Council News

## **Budget and Precept**

At the full council meeting held on 18<sup>th</sup> December 2023, Holton le Clay Parish Council set the precept request for 2024/25 at £76,772. This is an increase of 6% on the previous year – which equates to an increase of 0.26p per month per Band D household. The necessary budget for the coming year is £90,434, which will leave a shortfall of £13,662, which will be met by income from solar panels at the village hall, existing council funds and a substantial contribution to utilities by the village hall committee.

The Parish Precept supports the administration of the Parish Council, which in turn provides the following essential services to Holton le Clay:

- Cutting and maintaining the grass verges, 8 Acres Field and the Junior Playing Field
- Weed Spraying throughout the village
- Routine safety inspections and maintenance of the play equipment
- Provision and ongoing support of the village hall
- Provision and maintenance of the cemetery
- Daily litter collection in the village
- A staffed Parish Council office
- Active collaboration with Lincolnshire County Council and District Council regarding planning matters and issues pertaining to highways

One of the most popular things is having 'scraps' with your fish and chips. Back in Birmingham, we called them scratchings, and they do seem more popular here. One speciality of Holton Chippy is the homemade fish cakes. They are a good size, and they taste delicious, too.

Whilst I was in there chatting, locals came in and out. Lindsey knew precisely what they wanted and talked with each of them. Having been a part of the community for so long, they have seen children grow into adults and have their own families. It really is a hub of the Holton le Clay community: they have a connection with everyone in the village who uses it.

From chatting with people when we are out and about, we know their reputation spreads to surrounding villages and towns. People have told us they would rather travel to Holton le Clay than use their local chippy. That's a testament to the quality of the food.

# **Down on the Allotment**

March is a busy time on the allotment, as you need to prepare soil, sow seeds and plant out a huge variety of edible crops. Key jobs include weeding, sowing seeds and planting out. Only plant out when temperatures are above freezing, ensuring plants are hardy and have been hardened off (acclimatised to outside conditions) before planting. Pre-warming the soil with cloches or clear plastic sheeting can enable you to plant certain crops – such as broad beans – out sooner.





Sow beetroot, broad beans, salads and Swiss chard direct into wellprepared soil. You could also make early sowings

of carrots, peas, spinach and radishes if the soil is warm enough. You can also start off aubergines, chillies and peppers, plus tomatoes, under cover.

March is the last month for planting bare-root fruit trees and bushes. You can also plant bare-root strawberry runners, asparagus crowns and Jerusalem artichokes and plant out garlic, shallots and onion sets.

As I write this, it seems the Christmas and New Year periods have only just happened! For the Christian Church, as we come out of Epiphany, we begin the journey of Lent when we follow the journey of Jesus into Jerusalem. # **NEW WALTHAM CIRCULAR WALK**

The walk starts on Hewitt's Avenue, just past the little side road of Weelsby View, where there is parking along some of the side roads in this area. Once past Weelsby View, on the right is a narrow path marked with a public footpath sign. Follow the path around to the right and crossover Buck Beck, a stream running through the edge of the field. Then, head off across the field, following the well-defined footpath in a diagonal direction to a small gap between the trees.


Go through the gap and follow the footpath around to the left on the edge of a housing estate. The path follows through the woods with a beautiful avenue of trees, which finally leads out into an open area. Then, follow a small network of paths through the labyrinth of alleyways to finally reach Humberston Avenue via a metal divider to prevent cyclists from going straight onto the road. Turn left onto Humberston Avenue and walk a short distance (20 metres), then cross the road and go down a narrow alley between two houses.

This leads down into a large open field With a clearly defined path (at the time of writing, the field was full of rape oil seed in places up to 5 feet high). Follow the path in the direction of a small wood, keep to the left of the wood to pick up a wide grassy track.

Continue down the track to a multi connection of paths turns right, and then almost immediately turn left in

a diagonal direction, go past a pond on the right and head towards the right corner of a very large red brick house.

Once at the house, keep to the left and follow the gravel drive down towards a lane before the lane and about 150 metres down the drive take the path to the right; this is marked midway along with a single tree. Carry on along the path to the end and go through a gap in the hedge to join part of the old disused railway track.



Follow the track all the way back to reach Station Road finally. Go through the gate and turn right, cross the road carefully and take the first turning left, then head down Peaks Lane and follow all the way back to Hewitt's Avenue, then carry on back to the parked car.
