Seasonal Recipe of Salmon and spinach

Ingredients

1tsp oil
2 skinless salmon fillets
250g spinach
2 tbsp crème fraiche
Juice ½ lemon
1 tsp capers
2 tbsp chopped parsley
Lemon wedges to serve



Method

Heat the oil in the pan, season the salmon on both sides. Fry for 4 minutes each side until golden and the flesh flakes easily. Leave to rest on a plate.

Tip the spinach into a hot pan, season and cover. Leave to wilt for 1 minute, stirring occasionally.

Spoon the spinach onto the plates and top with the salmon.

Gently heat the crème fraiche with a squeeze of lemon, capers and parsley. Season to taste. Do not let it boil. Spoon the sauce over the fish and serve with lemon wedges. Bbcgoodfood.com

As I write this our gardens are beginning to show signs of plants flowering after the colourful show of various spring bulbs. Flowers not only bring rich colour to our gardens but they provide an important role to our environment. Flowers can feed birds, insects, animals and human beings. They aid in pollination by attracting bees and other insects which are pollinators so the plant can produce seeds and thus reproduce itself. Flowers may be given as gifts on special occasions; they are a way of expressing thoughts and feelings that words cannot fully explain. They come in various shapes, colours and fragrances. Those lovely blooms are effective in expressing our emotions, whether we want to say sorry for some mistake we've made or to express sorrow at the death of a loved one. Perhaps we're grateful for what someone has done for us, or want to help someone feel happy for no particular reason, only to say we love them. Jesus referred to flowers in his story about not worrying. He said, "Therefore I tell you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat; or about your body, what you will wear. For life is more than food, and the body more than clothes. "Consider how the wild flowers grow. They do not labour or spin. Yet I tell you, not even Solomon in all his splendour was dressed like one of these. If that is how God clothes the grass of the field, which is here today, and tomorrow is thrown into the fire, how much more will he clothe you—you of little faith!" (Luke 12: 22,23,27,28)
