Doorstep Fraud-Stay Safe!

Doorstep fraud involves criminals knocking on your door and unexpectedly offering products or services.

- If you are not sure, don't open your door. Callers can show you official credentials through a window.
- If you are unhappy with someone's identity, do not let them into your house. You do not have to open your door to say 'No thank you'.
- Legitimate builders do not call door to door, and they would never expect you to pay upfront for their services.
- If you do let someone in, never leave your front door open/unlocked and unattended so that a second individual can't enter without your knowledge.

A quiet ramble through two beautiful Lincolnshire villages.

From Tealby Tea Rooms walk down Front Street as far as B Leaning & Sons, butchers. Turn R into Church Lane, which becomes walkway. At top, turn L and cross over Rasen Road to follow public footpath that runs between houses on opposite side. As far as Walesby you will be following Norse helmet waymarks of Viking Way.

2 Cross rough pasture, aiming for stille in far bottom corner. Go over this and along path ahead, ignoring footbridge to L. Walk up hillside ahead to reach corner of **Bedlam Plantation** above **Castle Farm**.

Turn R. Cross stile for fenced path beside woods. At far end strike out diagonally L and down undulating grassy field to pass below Risby Manor Farm. Keep ahead, crossing deep valley, to reach R-H edge of Walesby Top Wood. Beyond stile path leads out across field to All Saints Church, Walesby. From church, continue along Viking Way as it drops down wide track then lane into village. At Rasen Road at bottom go straight on, past St Mary's Church, to junction with Catskin Lane.

⑤ If you need refreshment, cross road to Walesby House. Otherwise turn L and walk along Catskin Lane for ¾ mile (1.2km) until just past R-H curve, then turn L at entrance of farm drive and go over cattle grid. This public bridleway leads back up to hilltop, but you should turn R in few paces and join footpath route (not defined) across rough pasture, initially parallel with road. At large ploughed field go along its L-H side to meet drive to Castle Farm.

Oublic footpath continues east over field beyond. Path is waymarked at either end (at time of writing it had been ploughed; line of path indicated by sticks). At far side of field, cross stile and descend to cross footbridge. Turn R to rejoin route back to Tealby. This time turn L up Rasen Road to visit All Saints Church.

Vegan Courgette Cake

Ingredients

80g softened vegan butter block 175g golden caster sugar 2 lemons zested, one juiced 100ml plant milk 100g ground almonds 175g self-raising flour ½ tsp baking powder 175g courgettes, coarsely grated

200g icing sugar for topping

Method

2

Heat the oven to 180c/160c fan/gas 4. Butter and line a 900g loaf tin. Beat together the butter, sugar and lemon zest till combined. Add milk and beat slowly to combine. Add ground almonds, flour and baking powder, then grated courgette and combine. Spoon into the tin and level. Bake for 55-60 minutes or until the skewer comes out clean. Transfer to a wire rack and leave to cool in the tin.

Sieve icing sugar and add 1tbsp of the lemon juice and combine. Add a little more lemon juice if needed. Remove the cake from the tin and drizzle over the icing. Set for 30 minutes. Bbcgoodfood.com
