Even though it is still July as I write, I see signs of autumn around. There are red berries on the Rowan trees and the sycamore trees are dropping their keys. My garden has several sycamores on two sides of it and as autumn approaches those trees drop all their seeds on to the garden. We could grow a forest here but instead we pick out the tiny saplings as they come into the first leaf, and those on the lawns are mown up. Jesus, in the parable of the sower, spoke about the places the seeds were sown as they were scattered. In his day seeds were spread by hand and would fall in suitable and unsuitable places. He related this to how people received the word of God, some would listen and follow whilst others would ignore it or think about it before rejecting it. This is a parable we often consider at harvest time.

In our lives we often have decisions to make which can affect the way we live in the future. Youngsters have their exam results and need to decide on further studies but in what subject? Then there are decisions about jobs, who to share our life with and perhaps having children. Life is full of important decisions which we need to make wisely for our contentment and peace of mind. As Christians, we pray for God's guidance in all matters and for me this has always worked for the best, even if not for what I want.

#### In and around the potting shed



- Sow hardy annuals, such •
- as cerinthes, ammi, scabiosa and cornflowers, for flowers early next summer
- Lift gladioli corms, dry them off, then store in a frost-free shed or • garage over winter
- Plant wallflowers, pansies, forget-me-nots and other spring ٠ bedding in pots and borders
- Collect ripe seeds from your favourite flowers and store in labelled • envelopes, ready to sow in spring
- Plant up containers for autumn interest, • using cyclamen, heathers, heucheras and other colourful bedding plants
- Lift, divide and replant congested clumps of perennials, such as achilleas, once they finish flowering
- Apply vine weevil control to pots if plants show the tell-tale sign of . notched leaf margins
- Fill any gaps with late-flowering perennials, such as sedums, to • provide nectar for pollinating insects into autumn
- Plant spring bulbs in autumn, • including crocuses, daffodils, hyacinths, bluebells and snake's-head fritillaries in pots and borders
- Take cuttings from fuchsias, salvias and pelargoniums •
- Keep summer bedding flowering in hanging baskets and pots until ٠ the first frosts by deadheading and feeding regularly
- Trim conifer hedges to neaten them up and control height •
- Leave sunflower seedheads in place for birds to feed on

#### **Marrow Chutney**

1.5kg marrow, peeled and deseeded
225g shallots, sliced
225g apple, peeled, cored, sliced
225g sultanas
2cm ginger finely chopped
225g demerara sugar
850ml malt vinegar
12 black peppercorns



Cut the marrow into small pieces, put into a bowl and sprinkle liberally with 2 tbsp salt. Cover and leave for 12 hours.

Rinse and drain the marrow, then place in a preserving pan or large saucepan with the shallots, apples, sultanas, gingers, sugar and vinegar. Tie the peppercorns in muslin and add to the pan. Boil then reduce heat and simmer, stirring from time to time until thick.

Leave to settle for ten minutes then spoon into sterilised jars and add lid.

Will keep for a year in a cool, dark place.
