Foraging for Goodness

A lot of people live a frugal life by foraging; most of us are not suited to that style of living. But it doesn't mean we can't enjoy the free produce available within a few miles of our village.

Blackberries are in abundance and are a tasty addition to an apple or rhubarb pie. We actually cultivate one section of brambles in our garden specifically for this purpose. They also go well dropped into gin and allowed to infuse. Strain them off, and you have a lovely flavoured gin and some rather alcoholic berries!

Although I have been foraging for mushrooms, it's not something I would ever do without an expert. My limit is shaggy inkcaps which go well fried off in butter and eaten on some crusty toast.

Sloes and rosehips will also be in abundance. Sloes obviously go well infused in gin or port, but you can also make sloe syrup, sloe jelly, rosehip tea, vinegar and BBQ sauce. Rosehip tea has the benefit of being high in antioxidants and is good for several things.

If you go to the beach, you still might see some samphire, purslane, or salty fingers. All add a lovely salty flavouring to your food.

In the church calendar, November is a month in which many saintly people are celebrated. These days, most are hardly mentioned in the service, but one important day is 1st November, known as All Saints' Day, also known as All Hallows' Day, the day when the church celebrates in honour of all the saints of the church whether they are known or unknown. At the end of the month, 30th, it is St Andrew's Day.

St Andrew was an Apostle of Jesus and according to the New Testament he was a fisherman and one of Jesus' twelve disciples. He was initially a follower of John the Baptist but then recognised Jesus as the Messiah and followed him, introducing his brother Simon Peter at the same time. In the UK, we probably know Andrew as the patron saint of Scotland but he is claimed as such by many other countries also. Legend tells us his remains were taken to Scotland, though he never lived there. He is said to be the saint associated with fishermen, fishmongers and many other professions. St Andrew travelled on several missionary journeys telling people of God's love. Finally, he was crucified on a diagonal cross after insisting that he was unworthy to be crucified on the same shaped cross as Jesus. Andrew obeyed Jesus command to "go and make disciples of all nations, baptising them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." (Matthew 28: 19)



November Gardening



Whatsapp Friends and Family Crisis



Messages are sent purporting to be from a relative/friend from an unknown number. They claim their phone has been damaged, lost or stolen which is why they are using a different number. In some cases, correct names are being given, but this may just be luck rather than them knowing the name of your relative or friend.

The messages request to borrow money or pay for something [with a link in the message], stating that the alleged change in phone number means they temporarily can't access their usual online banking. They will also give some sort of excuse as to why the money can't be paid into their own account, so will give bank details of someone else.

STAY SAFE

ALWAYS verify requests in person or verbally to ensure you are speaking to the person that you think you are. If you receive a message like this, try contacting your loved one by calling the number you already have, not the 'new' one on Whatsapp.
