Congratulations to Margaret Wilkinson who has received a BEM in the New Year Honours for her services to the community of Holton-le-Clay.



Throughout the past 50 years, she has helped to organise and run the Summer, May Bank holiday and Christmas Fairs; she collated the Holton News for many years in her home as well as wrote many articles and distributed them. Along with Bernard (her husband), the Coulbecks and Sally Barton, she set up and ran the Shamrock Disco for over 10 years, which many people of a certain age will remember with great fondness.

For 41 years, she was the churchwarden and, as the vicar at the time said, it was thanks to her determination, insight, negotiating skills and fundraising that the church extension was built, providing the church with



a vestry, toilets, kitchen and meeting room. One of her greatest joys has been to lead the choir for most of the time since 1975 from a junior choir for children to its present form as a ladies' choir. These are just a few of the areas where Margaret has volunteered in the village for over half a century.

Her fundraising efforts for both the village and internationally, particularly Water Aid, have been calculated at raising over £250,000 over the past 50 years.

I would particularly like to thank all the wonderful people who took the time to write such thoughtful letters of support for her nomination. Your

numerous anecdotes, instances showing the impact of her work and humorous recollections have helped to truly demonstrate the difference she has made in so many lives of the people in the village.

Should it just be Happy Friends Day?



There are some unusual traditions around the world for Valentine's Day. Here are just a few.

In South Korea, women give men chocolates in February. On *white day*, a whole month later, men give chocolates to women. Not to be outdone, a month later is *black day* for singles who get together to celebrate with all their single friends.

In Norway, funny little poems are sent. These gaekkrbrev have to be guessed from the series of dots for each letter of the name. if the poem's author is guessed, they get an easter egg at easter!

February brings the church to the end of the Christmas/Epiphany seasons, forty days after Christmas. It is celebrated on 2nd February as Candlemas or the Feast of the Presentation of Jesus Christ and the Feast of the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Candlemas is based on Mary and Joseph presenting Jesus at the Temple (Luke 2) and Mary, following the Jewish rules in Leviticus 12, which decrees a woman is to be purified by presenting a lamb as a burnt offering and a young pigeon or dove as a sin offering.

In some countries, it is considered time to take down the Christmas decorations. Here, we do it at Epiphany, 6th January. At our church, for Candlemas, we meet for a simple meal followed by a short service during which candles are lit. These candles serve as a symbol of Jesus Christ, who is referred to as the Light of the World.

Candles are a significant feature in the church as they symbolise the Light of Christ and the hope and joy that comes from Jesus' birth, death and resurrection. This helps those who come to worship to focus more clearly. Sometimes, we give people a candle when they come to church for special sacraments, such as a baptism, to remind them that Jesus is with them all the time and his light shines through all throws of life.

John 8:12: Jesus says, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life".
