Your monthly gardening checklist gardenersworld.com

- Sow hardy annuals, such as love-in-a-mist and pot marigolds, as well as native wildflowers, into gaps in borders
- Enjoy instant colour by planting primulas and polyanthus in pots and at the front of borders
- Protect the new shoots of hostas, delphiniums, lupins and other vulnerable plants from slugs and snails
- Continue deadheading spring bulbs and bedding, so they don't waste energy setting seed
- Plant pineapple lily (eucomis) bulbs in pots for exotic-looking summer flowers
- Sow sweet peas at the base of supports, and transplant those sown in autumn into their final positions
- Spray the new leaves of disease-prone roses with fungicide to control mildew, rust and black spot
- Take basal cuttings from clumps of perennials, such as delphiniums, campanulas and lupins
- Prune hydrangeas, cutting back the old stems to a healthy shoot lower down
- Reinvigorate mature clumps of hardy perennials, such as hostas, asters and daylilies, by dividing and replanting
- Sow sunflowers in a sunny, open site, then water regularly and protect seedlings from slugs and snails
- Check for aphids on roses and rub them off before they develop into major infestations
- Add aquatic plants, such as waterlilies and irises, to garden ponds

#### Ravenser Odd

Cast your mind back a mere 750 years to a little island called Ravenser Odd.

It began life as a port on the narrow spit of shingle and clay at Spurn Head that forms the north bank of the Humber. The 1299 charter made it into a borough and exempted merchants from some taxes. The town was then able to build its own court, jail and chapel and had two members of parliament. Life in the town was lawless

By the mid-14th century, the storms and strong tidal currents of the North Sea began to take their toll on the settlement. A devastating blow was dealt in 1362 by the storm surge of St Marcellus's flood, after which the town began to be abandoned.

The very forces that created the land that Ravenser was situated on – and gave it an advantage over other ports on the Humber – were to end its preeminence as a trading hub. As recorded in the Meaux Abbey Chronicle, by the end of the 14th century, corpses in the graveyard were being exposed by the sea. There were reports of looting of the chapel by "sacrilegious persons".

The Holderness coastline, to the north of the Spurn peninsula, is the fastest

eroding coastline in Europe. Its crumbling cliffs of soft boulder clay are retreating at an average rate of two metres a year.

Thirty settlements are known to have been lost. The location of Ravenser Odd, though, has long remained contested because the historical evolution of Spurn Head remains uncertain. There have been no reports of structures from Ravenser for over 500 years Suggested locations are thus linked to the various theories on the evolution of Spurn Head.

#### **Rhubarb Crumble Muffins**

makes 12

Ingredients

175g caster sugar
175g diced rhubarb
2 tsp sunflower oil
1 egg
1 tsp vanilla extract
125ml buttermilk
200g plain flour
1 tsp baking powder

1 tsp bicarbonate of soda

Crumble topping 50g light muscovado sugar 50g plain flour 25g porridge oats 1 tsp ground cinnamon 50g butter



Method

1. Heat oven to 220c/200c fan/gas 7. Line a 12-hole muffin tin with paper cases. Stir the sugar and rhubarb together and set aside while you make crumble. Mix the muscovado sugar with the flour, oats and cinnamon, then rub in the butter until clumpy, using your fingertips.

2. Stir the oil and egg, vanilla and buttermilk into the sugary rhubarb. Now add the flour, baking powder and bicarbonate of soda and stir well.

3. Quickly spoon into the cases, then scatter each with a thick layer of the crumble mixture. Bake for 15-18 minutes until golden and a cocktail stick comes out clean. Cool on a wire rack.
