The day before, we get as much done indoors as we can, and on the morning of the event, we are there from 9 am to let stall holders in and finally lock up after 6 pm, once we have put everything away and tidied up. Parish Council News



Budget and Precept.

At the full council meeting held on 20th January 2025, Holton le Clay Parish Council set the precept request for 2025/26 at £81,378. This is an increase of 6% on the previous year – and equates to an increase of 29p per month per Band D household. The necessary budget for the new financial year is £96,179, which will leave a shortfall of £14,801, which will be met by income from solar panels at the village hall, existing council funds and a contribution to utilities by the village hall committee. The parish precept supports the administration of the parish council,

which in turn provides the following essential services to Holton le Clay:

- Cutting and maintaining grass verges, the 8 acres playing field and the Junior Playing Field
- Weed spraying throughout the village
- Routine safety inspections and maintenance of play equipment
- Provision and maintenance of the cemetery
- Provision and ongoing support of the village hall
- Active collaboration with Lincolnshire County Council and District Council regarding planning matters and issues pertaining to highways
- Provision and maintenance of parish gardens

March brings us to the time of year leading to Easter. Lent for Christians is a time for reflection on what God wants from us. Not everyone holds a faith in God and perhaps are not even interested but for all of us, Christians or non-Christians, taking time to reflect quietly may awaken our thoughts to be ready to take up a new challenge in our lives.

Jesus followed God's leading all the way to Jerusalem where he appeared before the Court for an offence of blasphemy but all he was doing was being who he was, teaching the love of God and healing those who were sick. He was rejected by most but he continued his mission even to death on the cross. His adult life was short but he fulfilled his purpose and people have been blessed through his determination to bring God to humanity. His human life was not easy due to politics, poor economy and unhelpful relationships. What's new?

Jesus didn't give up; he persevered to make a change and to bring freedom to everyone who believed in him. That's still true today.

As we approach Easter, how we could make a difference in these difficult economic times, perhaps to help someone who is facing problems. We may just have the answer!

In Jesus' story of the sheep and goats, Jesus spoke of the hungry, the thirsty, the stranger, the unclothed, the sick and the prisoner. He rewarded those who offered love and care to such people with the promise of being with God for eternity. He said, "Whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me." (Matthew 25: 31-46) *Rev'd Jenny*

Did you know?

- Who organises the Village Hall events? There is a team of just fourteen volunteers that organise the events at the hall.
- How do I hire the village hall for a party? Just give Maureen a call, her number is on the inside front cover and on page 1.
- Who makes the cakes for afternoon tea? Most of the volunteers love baking. They bake at least 160 cakes and sausage rolls between them every year.
- What happens to the income the hall makes? ALL the money goes into paying for the free events we hold, especially the Summer Fayre, which costs between £4,000-£5000 to put on.
- Where do the raffle prizes come from? MERC, The Village Hall supply some, along with our lovely local businesses and residents. Everyone is very generous.
- How long does it take to organise the Summer Fayre? We start planning the fayre in January. We look for new and exciting things that families would enjoy to make each year different and fun!
- Who receives the Holton News? We have a team of monthly volunteers who distribute all over the village to 1800 homes and businesses. That's 21,600 copies a year, meaning 43,200 staples!
- What else do you pay for? The funds also pay for the caretakers, insurance, decorating, cleaning, and equipment, and much more.
- Who pays for the magazine? The advertising income in the magazine covers a large portion of costs, and MERC pays the rest. We would love a sponsor to cover the printing costs.
