Defibrillators

There are two community defibrillators within the village. They are located on the side of the village hall in Pinfold Lane and on the side of the Vintage Car Garage on Louth Road.

Precept

The precept has been now been set for the year 2019/20. The parish council has not increased the precept for the last 3 years but due to ever increasing costs the decision has been made to increase it this year by 1%. This will mean an increase of 0.47p per household.

Winter Weather - Salt Available

There is a limited amount of salt available at the Parish Council Office for resident's personal use during severe winter weather. The salt is located at the far end of the village hall car park and is available during opening hours.

Anglian Water

As many of you are aware Anglian Water will be starting work in the village in February to reinforce the water main between Holton le Clay and North Thoresby. The work will begin in Pinfold Lane on 18th February for 8 weeks and Silver Street and Louth Road will follow. There will be temporary lights at each location and some lane closures. The very last book of the Bible goes by the name of Revelation.



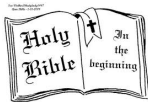
