#### 68. TO RECEIVE AND ACCEPT APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE:

## 69. TO RECEIVE DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LOCALISM ACT 2011:

## 70. TO APPROVE THE MINUTES OF THE FULL COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON 15<sup>th</sup> SEPTEMBER 2025:

The minutes of the full council meeting held on 15<sup>th</sup> September were approved and duly signed by the Chair.

#### 71. TO RECEIVE AN UPDATE FROM MERC:

- The village hall floor has now been refurbished with a fresh coat of varnish

- The cake counter has been given a fresh new look with a new counter top donated by Howdens Grimsby and fitted by Stewart Ashton and Mark Dodge.
- The volunteers have been having a clear out of electrical items that are no longer used and have managed to raise £280 so far by selling off old stereo systems and cameras etc.
- A fashion show will be held at the village hall on 21<sup>st</sup> October at 12.30pm
- The Pebble Hunt will be coming back again on 27<sup>th</sup> October and will last until 31<sup>st</sup>. Eagle eyed children who find the pebbles will be able to collect a prize.
- The Remembrance Day luncheon will take place again this year on 9<sup>th</sup> November following the service at the A16 memorial.
- Now that the Holton News is no longer in production, refunds are being issued to those who paid for advertising space. Funds are limited and Councillor Aldridge is kindly helping with this by awarding a district council grant.
- The annual Christmas market will be held on 15<sup>th</sup> November at the Village Hall. Santa will be in his grotto and there will be treats and games for everyone.

There isn't much to report from the district council this month. In terms of planning, they await the revisions from the government to the National Planning Policy Framework.
