Will We Remember Them!

Currently I am reading 'The Boy who followed his Father into Auschwitz' a book by Jeremy Dronfield. A true story about a Jewish Father and Son who went into concentration camps and the hardships and suffering they faced. The son had an opportunity to leave and emigrate to America and possibly be with his brother but wouldn't leave his father. When his father was sent to Auschwitz (almost a death sentence) he volunteered to go with him.

They (but not all their family) managed to survive somehow the whole of the war. Mother and youngest sister were transported to Poland where they were shot and buried in mass pits along with over 1,000 other women, children and the elderly a short time after their arrival that same day. Some years ago I also read 'Hiroshima' by John Hersey about the suffering caused to the people of that city when the atomic bomb was dropped. Both books are uncomfortable to read and raise many questions.

What is clear is that as we remember and we give thanks for those who defended and continue to defend us, sometimes with their lives, we also need to remember the suffering of the many civilians caught up in warfare as well.

Defibrillators There are two community defibrillators within the village. They are located on the side of the village hall in Pinfold Lane and on the side of the Vintage Car Garage on Louth Road.

Dog Waste Please pick up after your dogs. We are receiving lots of reports of dog fouling in the village – particularly on the 8 Acres Playing Field. Village Hall The Village Hall 1st floor renovations are now complete with the recent installation of a lift. The first floor looks amazing following its refurbishment and it is hoped it will be used and enjoyed by everyone.
