Holton-le-Clay Parish Council who are responsible for the village grass cutting, the village Maintenance Operative, the Junior Playing Field, the 8 Acre field, the Cemetery & Parish Gardens, Provision of (but not running of) the Village Hall.

Defibrillators There are two community defibrillators within the village. They are located on the side of the village hall in Pinfold Lane and on the side of the Vintage Car Garage on Louth Road.

Cemetery A team from Anglian Water and members of the Parish Council have been busy planting Daffodil, Crocus and Iris bulbs in the Cemetery driveway. £100 was spent on the bulbs by the parish council and Anglian Water kindly matched this. The driveway will look beautiful in the spring with the different coloured flowers brightening up the area.

Also on the Cemetery, a new turning circle has been added at the end of the driveway. This is to enable cars to turn around safely without churning up the mud.

Dog Waste_There are now bottles filled with poo bags on the lamp posts in most areas of the village. Please help to keep the village clean by using the bags and depositing them in the nearest litter bin. If you notice the bottles are running low please free to pop some of your own bags in for other dog walkers.

8 Acres The Parish Council has purchased 4 new benches for the 8 Acres Playing Field which will be installed this month.
