Thought for July 2015 Human Rites?

We have just celebrated the Magna Carta and how it began our Law and Justice System of today. It is why we don't have a Bill of Rights as it is superfluous in our democracy. ACTIONS SPEAK LOUDER THAN WORDS

Charles Blondin was one of the world's greatest funambulists (that's a tightrope walker), and on the 15th of September, 1860 he performed one of the most amazing stunts the world has ever seen. Before a great crowd, Blondin walked a tightrope stretched across Niagara Falls in Canada. The tightrope was 49 metres (160 feet) above the Falls, and it stretched for 335 metres (1,100 feet) across.

After that, Blondin crossed over Niagara Falls on a tightrope any times. On one occasion he stopped in the middle and cooked an omelette.

Another time he wheeled a wheelbarrow over the falls. After Blondin had walked one way, he asked the crowd if they believed he could wheel a person across in a wheelbarrow. They all shouted 'Yes!' because he was the greatest tightrope walker in the world. So he then asked for a volunteer – but no one spoke up! No one was prepared to trust Blondin and put what they believed into practice. But one person did trust Blondin. He was Henry Colcord, Blondin's manager. On the 17th of August, 1859 Blondin walked over the falls on a tightrope carrying Henry Colcord on his back. Colcord alone had real confidence and trust in Blondin's skill as a tightrope walker.



The crowd in this story all said they believed in the abilities of Blondin, but when they were challenged to do something about it no one moved. They weren't prepared to put their belief into action! Every day people say they believe in things but are these beliefs important enough to do something about it? Perhaps we genuinely do believe, but pressure from those around us – from our friends outside school, from our family, from our classmates – stops us from making a commitment.

Maybe you believed it was important to revise hard for your exams, but your friend persuaded you against it. Perhaps you believe it is important to help and support younger students, but pressure from others has led you into bullying.

Let us think about what we believe and whether we act on our beliefs or allow others to influence us to compromise those beliefs.
