Thought for November 2015 Remember. Remember?

Russia has entered the fray in Syria, claims are being made that ISIS are in retreat and melting away with their fighters and supporters being more afraid to stay than to escape. Assad's regime is bolstered and given some legitimacy by Putin's support. The West's view is that Russia is targeting all Assad's enemies, as well as ISIS, increasing Putin's influence in the Middle East. If Russia can stop the bloodshed and stabilise Syria it will be a victory of sorts and may start to reverse the tide of Islamic terrorism but the recriminations will go on with Assad's opponents being hunted down.

Russia's militarization is worrying, as seen in Crimea and our air space but so is our willingness to interfere in other nations' affairs when Russia was weak. Now the roles are reversing with us being weaker, we have to treat Russia with caution in our dealings, as Churchill said "better to jaw jaw than to war war."

The flow of refugees from Syria may slow down but the genie is out of the bottle with the destabilisation of the region with the West's interventions. We still have a problem as a result. In Europe we have to deal with the massive influx of people but also at home with radicalisation, with islamophobia and far right groups. Remembrance is not just about the sacrifices of the past but also the sacrifices we need to make today. Jesus said "Anyone who comes after me must deny themselves take up their cross and follow me." Matt 16.23
