Thought for December, 2014 A Child of Hope!

For Christians, Christmas is a time of hope, renewing our wonder at what is called the Incarnation: God becoming one of us, both fully human and yet fully divine. It is something that people have argued about from the word go in order to understand how this can be. But isn't something that is provable like a maths problem, although we speak in metaphor as though it is, it's much more something like a relationship, some thing that feels right. It's not exactly measureable but it is observable like a mothers love. Christmas is about observing the love of God in action and then recognizing it in ourselves.

For Christians, Christmas is also a time of sadness in that it has become associated with a time of much greed, excess and selfishness. Yes, we all want to celebrate but it should be about love. Charity (a Greek word we translate as love) does get a bit of a look in but mostly as an afterthought as we pass by street collectors tins. There is so much hype about Christmas it's no wonder we often find it rather hollow despite the good works of many.

To have a child should be a wondrous thing but the pressure is on to go back to work as soon as possible and leave the care to someone else at the most formative and precious time. The bond between parent and child is forged in those early years and we seem to go all out to ruin it. Parenthood is THE most important and valuable job in the world. Yet Governments don't really value it and we wonder at the breakdown of communities and the behaviour problems in schools and beyond. We just don't see the link. We don't build people or communities by setting targets but by giving of ourselves to others. Jesus said "Love one another as I have love you." Jn 15 vs12

<u>Thought for March, 2015</u> Scripture, Tradition and Reason!

Traditionally Lent is a season of discipline, and that can sound a negative thing, as we often connect it with punishment but discipline is about learning, Jesus' disciples were learners as are all Christians and other people of faith because they were learning how to live out their faith, intellectually and practically. However a fan is different, as to follow a person or something doesn't mean that you become a better person, just because you know all the words to 'Agadoo' or 'The Sound of Music.'

It is important when learning not only to receive the lesson but to test it - to see if it stands up to scrutiny and then put it into practice. I heard that Stephen Fry is an atheist as he doesn't believe in the capricious God of the Old Testament or that a God would inflict such disease and suffering on the world. I don't believe a God like that either but I'm not an atheist. The problem of pain is a difficult issue for all people of faith (and of none) but it doesn't mean that there cannot be a good God.

The God of the Old Testament is multifaceted and dependent upon the culture and understanding of the particular writer. There is a development in understanding of the nature of God that continues into the New Testament and beyond. Just because people have a faith doesn't mean they leave their brains behind - rather the opposite. Lent isn't about confirming our prejudices but often challenging them.

Mary Magdalene's Story

I was one of the first people to witness the greatest miracle in history. That was a highpoint of my life. But my story didn't start there. If you had met me earlier in my life, you would never have believed God would choose me to play a special part in his plans. I guess you could say I'm proof that God really does change lives!

When I first met Jesus, I was a complete mess. They made my life miserable - they ruined my relationships with other people and with God. I But when I met Jesus, my life changed forever. He cast out the evil spirits and made me a new person. After that I followed Jesus wherever he went. was part of a small group of women who travelled with Jesus and gave money to support him and his disciples. But after a while, things started getting tense. The religious leaders got really angry at Jesus. One awful night they had Jesus arrested and decided he should be killed - even though he hadn't done anything wrong! When they hung Jesus on the cross, many of his other followers left. Maybe they were scared or just didn't know what to do. But I wasn't going anywhere. I stayed right there with Jesus, near the cross.

I stayed there until he died, and I watched as he was buried. One Sunday morning, as soon as I could, I rushed to the tomb where they' placed Jesus' body, I was expecting to find him there dead. But it was the strangest thing – the big stone that covered the opening of the tomb was rolled back. The tomb was open! I peeked inside, but Jesus' body wasn't there. He was gone!

I was so upset. I went outside and tried to figure out what might have happened. I saw a man standing nearby, and I thought he might be the gardener. I asked him if he had taken Jesus somewhere. "Mary," he said. All at once I knew it was Jesus! He was alive!

Jesus had told us many times that he would be raised from the dead, but I didn't really understand it before. Now here I was, the first person to see Jesus when he came back to life. His resurrection was the biggest miracle in history.

I ran as fast as I could to tell Jesus' other friends what I had found out. Jesus was alive, and he chose me – a changed woman – to share the good news!

Tales from a Country Plumber - No 1 of an occasional series

One of my favourite jobs during my 50 years as a plumber, was installing mains water into houses which had either worked on a pump system or had had no water supply at all! I sometimes find it hard to believe that mains water supply only came to Holton le Clay in December 1947 and the first person to receive it was Mrs E Metcalf in Clay Lane. At that time the population of Holton was just over 1000.
