Summer Cup Mocktail

A fruity mocktail that's cool and refreshing

- 1cm thick slice of cucumber
- 1 sprig mint
- few frozen red berries
- 120ml clear, sparkling lemonade
- ice


To garnish: more frozen berries, chopped fruits, cucumber slice, mint, citrus – all optional

Method

Chop the cucumber and mint sprig into small pieces. Bring 200ml water to the boil in a small pan and then add the mint and cucumber. Turn off the heat and leave for 2 mins. Add a small handful of frozen berries, let them defrost for a minute, then crush them lightly with the back of a spoon. Strain the mixture. This will keep in the fridge for up to 24 hours and will be enough to make four drinks.

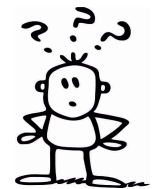

Holton le Clay Camera Club

We are a small group of amateur photographers who meet on the first Tuesday of each month at Holton Le Clay village hall at 7.15pm to 9.45pm **Monthly Club night.** Our monthly meetings at the Village Hall gives us the chance to develop our camera skills further by discovering new techniques though practical activity. We support and help each other on the practical nights and usually share and view our photos the following month. We feel that as a group it is important to share and view each other's photos and this is incorporated in the evening when towards the end we sit down with a cup of tea/coffee and spend 20 – 30 minutes viewing the previous months photos which members wish to share.

Monthly Challenge. To encourage us to keep snapping we have an informal monthly challenge where members can submit photos on the monthly theme to be viewed at the next club meeting.

Annual Photo Challenge. For those wishing to take part, we run an annual challenge – this takes the form of 12 photos taken during the year with a set category. The categories are chosen by club members and split into four sections to be submitted quarterly. The photos are judged against set criteria and the photograph which scores the most points at the end of the year is awarded the HLCCC trophy.

As well as the monthly meetings we try and organize at least two or three extra meet ups at local locations to further our practical skills and see the local area through the lens of a camera.

The club is hosting a photography exhibition at the Albert Room at Cleethorpes Library Monday 8th October to Monday 17th October. Entry to the exhibition is free.
