#### **Parish Council News**

#### **Defibrillators**

There are three community defibrillators within the village. They are located on the side of the village hall in Pinfold Lane, on the side of the Vintage Car Garage on Louth Road and on the 8 Acres playing field near the Beech Grove entrance.

#### <u>Vandalism</u>

Once again, the Spring Rider on the junior playing field has been vandalised. Someone is removing the handles, bolts, and foot pegs from the play equipment, making it pretty much unusable. The parish council has had to replace the parts twice in the last few months at a cost of around £40 each time.

#### Winter Weather Salt

There is a limited amount of salt available at the Village Hall for residents' personal use during severe weather. The salt is located at the far end of the car park and is available during office opening hours.

WHICH COUNCIL? Holton-le-Clay comes under a three tier Council System and as such it can sometimes be confusing as to who to contact when. Lincolnshire County Council who are responsible for Schools, Highways (including Street Lights and Pot Holes), Local Recycling centres (Tips), Transport and Health & Care issues and along with several other things they can be contacted on 01522-552222.

**East Lindsey District Council** who are responsible for Refuse Collection, Bottle banks, Planning, Licensing and Benefits along with several other things, they can be contacted on **01507-601111.** 

**Holton-le-Clay Parish Council** who are responsible for the village grass cutting, the village Maintenance Operative, the Junior Playing Field, the 8 Acre field, the Cemetery & Parish Gardens, Provision of (but not running of) the Village Hall.



#### SCAMS

If you receive a phone call, text or email asking you to hand over personal or financial information, you need to take a moment to reflect and step back from the situation.

**YES**, even if they say they're from the BANK, POLICE or another trusted <u>organisation</u>, you should still take the time to stop and think about what is

really going on.

**NEVER** disclose security details, such as your PIN or full banking details including passwords.

**DON'T** assume an email or phone call is authentic.

**DON'T** be rushed or pressured into making a decision.

LISTEN to your instincts.

STAY in control.

ALWAYS remember the police will never contact you and ask for any of your banking details and neither would your bank.

IT IS A SCAM IF:

- Someone offers you something that seems too good to be true.
- You are pressurised into agreeing something too quickly.
- You are asked to hand over your bank/credit card details on a cold call.

When we moved here three years ago, I was 48 introverted and a bit lonely as my husband worked long hours in the building trade for six days a week. I was only working part-time and spending too much time at home on my own. Life was slipping me by.



I decided to start volunteering. I could bake, but I'd lost my mojo. So, I thought that helping out at the village hall afternoon tea might help get it back. Well, it did far more for me than that!

I jumped in at the deep end and baked for the December tea on a Tuesday; then, I baked again for the Christmas Fayre on Saturday. It was so busy on both days that I didn't know whether I was coming or going. But I enjoyed it. I realised I like having a go at something different - like pumpkin pie and biscoff cheesecake.

Slowly but surely, it got easier. I made friends with a very welcoming bunch of people who all wanted to give something to the community and bring people together. They helped me believe in myself, and I helped enrol a few more volunteers with a recruitment drive.

With a bit of newfound confidence, I even plucked up the courage to apply for a position on the parish council. I believe the more you put into your community, the more you get out of it. I like to think I care enough to try and make a difference - to help make this village a better place to live for current as well as future residents.

Volunteering has done more than help me get my baking mojo back; it has changed my life.

#### A New Year

I wonder what our hopes are for 2023. Most people have thoughts about things they want to change at the beginning of a new year. It begins something like, "This year I will..." "I will what?" Perhaps it will be for better health and fitness, relaxation or closer ties with friends and family. I've been perusing the minute books of the Holton le clay parish council, which date back to 1909 and I thought I would share some of the interesting bits.

This one caught my eye as being particularly interesting in that we forget teenagers causing nuisance isn't a new thing and that all

generations have been guilty in the past.

"December 11<sup>th</sup> 1935,

Proposed by Mr Smith, seconded by Mr Mason, that the superintendent of police be written to about the conduct of certain of the village youths within the past week or so. 5 windows broken in the Institute, sign posts, lettered directions broken off, railings leading to Church Close to Mr Stephenson's broken. Also a large electric cable drum, which had been left on the grass verge by the telephone people, was removed and rolled down a steep bank and crashed to the bottom of the dyke. Youths collect in the vicinity of the post office and amuse themselves by kicking doors and being very noisy."



I imagine the youths involved in 1935 grew up into fine young men a few years later.
