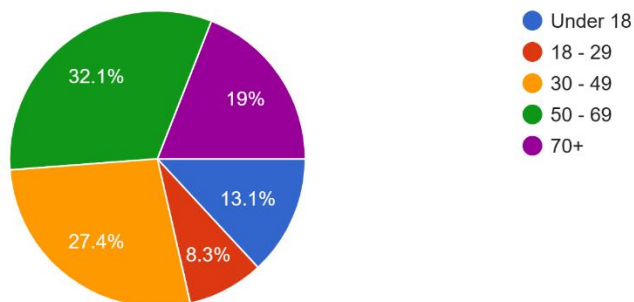


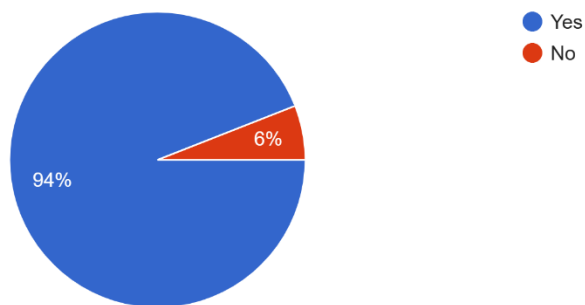
What Is Your Age Group?

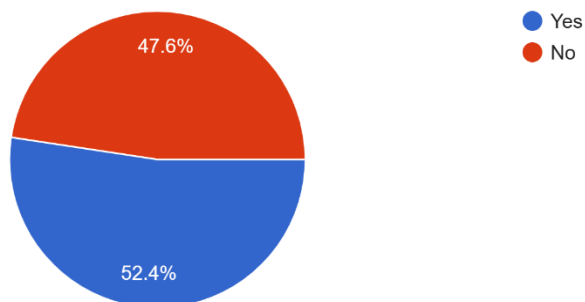
Should there be more sporting facilities in Holton le Clay?

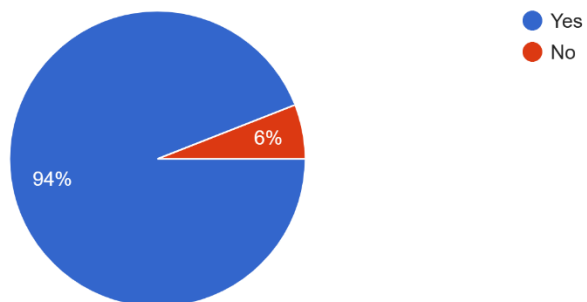
If a Skate park was provided at no cost to residents, would you use it?

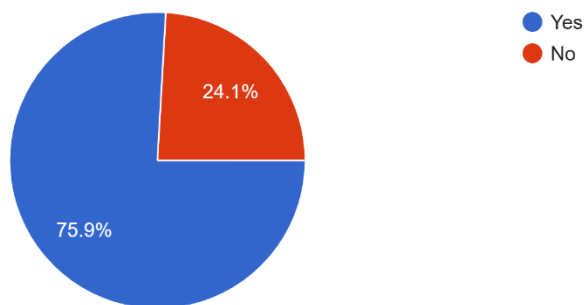
Would you be happy with a selection of equipment to suit all ages and abilities?

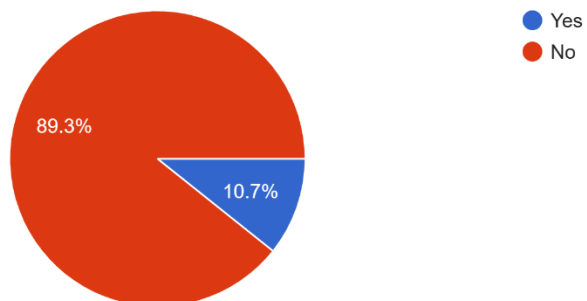
Do you agree that a skate park will help to reduce anti social behaviour?
