Did you know?

Holton le Clay Village Hall

When the Parish Council decided to purchase the disused Etherington Arms to restore into a Village Hall, they needed a group to raise funds for the restoration and run the building once completed.

Holton le Clay Multi-purpose Educational Resource Centre (HLC MERC) was formed as a charity and successfully raised the funds needed to provide a facility to suit the whole village, along with a contribution from the Church once the Church Hall was sold.

Once completed, the Hall has attracted a wide variety of bookings, from many different exercise classes to dances, craft fairs, blood donor sessions, clubs, elections and many children's parties. So many that they now have an almost fully booked timetable each week.

The committee is made up of volunteers dedicated to providing a Village Hall to be proud of. They give up many hours planning events and maintaining the building.

Monthly Afternoon Teas are organised by them, with all cakes baked and provided free of charge by the committee members who volunteer to run the afternoon.

All funds raised are used to provide more community events, such as the annual Summer Fayre for the enjoyment of residents, and it's wonderful to see so many turn out each year. Quarterly Quiz Nights are arranged and run by volunteers as well as an annual Christmas Market shopping event. HLC MERC also compiles and undertakes the time-consuming distribution of the Holton News to the whole village with the help of their editor and more volunteers from around the village.

Marrow/Courgette Chutney

Perfect recipe to use up a glut of marrows or courgettes

Ingredients

1.5kg/3lb 5oz marrow or courgettes

- 225g/8oz sliced shallots
- 225g/8oz peeled, cored and sliced apple

225g/8oz sultanas

225g/8oz demerara sugar

850ml/28fl oz malt vinegar

2cm/1inch ginger finely chopped

12 black peppercorns



Method

1.Cut the marrow/courgettes into small pieces, out into a bowl and sprinkle liberally with 2 tbsp salt. Cover and leave for 12 hours.

2.Rinse and drain then place in a pan with shallots, apples, sultanas, ginger, sugar and vinegar. Tie the peppercorns in muslin [or into an enclosed tea strainer] and place in the pan. Bring to the boil, then reduce the heat and simmer. Stirring from time to time until the consistency is thick. Remove peppercorns.

3.Leave to settle for ten minutes, then spoon into sterilised jars. Add lid and label.

Will keep for a year in a cool, dark place.

Gardening in September

1 Divide herbaceous perennials



- 2 Pick Autumn raspberries
- 3 Collect and sow seeds from perennials and hardy annuals
- 4 Dig up remaining potatoes before slug damage spoils them
- 5 Net ponds before leaf fall gets underway
- 6 Keep up with watering of new plants, using rain or grey water if possible
- 7 Start to reduce the frequency of houseplant watering
- 8 Clean out cold frames and greenhouses so that they are ready for use in the autumn
- 9 Cover leafy vegetable crops with bird-proof netting
- 10 Plant spring flowering bulbs
