The late John 'Ben' Casey

It was a privilege that I and two Parish Councillors, David Springett and Chris Lyons, attended the unveiling of a commemorative bench in memory of John 'Ben' Casev at the Memorial Gardens. Ben was an SAS member. originally from the parachute regiment, who sadly lost his life in Oman aged just thirty-one.

Emma [Parish Clerk] covered the details in last month's article but could not attend due to a prior engagement. She deserves praise for liaising with the regiment to get the bench in situ and for trying to locate members of Ben's family.



It was a pleasure to talk with his fellow paras, some of whom had travelled many miles to celebrate the life of Ben-notably Tommy Simpson, who fought alongside him.

The Parish Councillors were honoured to assist with unveiling the bench, and the standard bearer lowered the flag as the last post was played. It was a very poignant moment. Ron Webster of the Parachute Regiment and Airborne forces group then laid a poppy wreath.

As Ben is buried in the Holton le Clay cemetery, the paras went to pay their respects to him at the graveside.

Curried Fishcakes

Serves 4

Batch bake and have these handy in the freezer. **Ingredients**

500g Maris Piper potatoes in 3cm chunks

3 large garlic cloves crushed

1 thumb sized piece of ginger, peeled & grated

2-3 tbsp curry powder [optional]

4 cod/haddock fillets

400ml semi-skimmed milk 1 small lemon zested and juiced 150g plain flour 2 medium eggs, beaten

2 medium eggs, beaten



Method

Boil potatoes till tender, drain and leave before lightly crushing. Heat a little oil and fry off garlic, ginger and curry powder for 1 minute. Then stir through the potatoes.

Simmer cod in the milk, remove from heat, cover and set aside for 10 minutes to poach. Remove the fish and discard the skin.

Flake into the potato and fold in the lemon zest and juice.

Shape into eight fishcakes.

Dip each fishcake into flour, then egg, then breadcrumbs. [freeze at this point]

Heat oil and fry on medium heat for 5-6 minutes each side.

St Peter's Church Christmas is upon us.
